- Powerpoint


INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Pick a famous person that is successful in an occupation or career that you want to do or something that you are curious about.
- 2) Do some research on this person. **TAKE NOTES** (1-2 points per question) of your research (can be point form) as you will need to submit this.

Do your research based on the following questions:

Research Questions

- What was their childhood like? Where did they grow up? Stories about their family?
- Were there any events in their childhood that they needed to overcome? What did they learn about themselves through this event?
- What education did they have?
- What steps did they take towards his/her occupation?
- Why are they so successful in this occupation?





Research Questions Continued

- What personal characteristics/traits do they have that connect to this occupation?
- What part of their process was luck and what part was earned?
- What is their life philosophy based on the life choices they made?

Remember to take notes on what you found!

- 3) Choose 3 of the following questions and answer them as if YOU were the famous person (2-3 sentences each).
 - Why do you feel you would be perfect for this job?
 - What are your best qualities and how do those qualities help you in this job?
 - Tell me about a time when you had to deal with a conflict and how did you resolve it?
 - What is the most important thing you learned at school?
 - What was the most difficult period in your life and how did you deal with it?
 - What are the qualities that make a good leader? A bad leader?
 - If you could choose one superpower, what would it be and why?
- 4) Submit your assignment with your research and interview question answers in either **WORD** or **PDF**
